

Life Line Screening goes beyond regular checkups to look inside your arteries for signs of plaque build-up

Carotid Artery Disease: An ultrasound is performed to screen the carotid arteries (a pair of blood vessels in the neck that deliver blood to your brain) for buildup of fatty plaque. This buildup, called atherosclerosis, is one of the leading causes of stroke.

Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD):

An Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) test is performed using blood pressure cuffs on the arms and legs. It is important to screen for PAD because it increases the risk of coronary artery disease, heart attack, or stroke,1

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA):

An ultrasound is performed to screen the abdominal aorta for the presence of an enlargement or aneurysm. AAA can lead to a ruptured aortic artery, which is a life-threatening and other heart-related medical emergency.



Atrial Fibrillation :

A 6-lead

electrocardiogram (EKG) is performed by placing sensors on the arms and legs to screen for Atrial Fibrillation, AFib can lead to blood clots. stroke, and heart failure, complications.2

How You Can You Help? It is estimated that one in six children in Missouri faces hunger on a regular basis. Studies show children who face food insecurity are more likely to have problems at school and are more likely to suffer from anxiousness and irritability. Each Friday during the school year, Camdenton schools send home a bag of nutritious food to children who rely on free or reduced-price lunches. The bags include ready to eat entrees, a fruit cup, cereal and a nutritional bar with Peanut Butter once a month. The Camdenton schools are sending home approximately 250 Buddy Packs per week to students in Dogwood, Hawthorn and Oak Ridge Elementary schools plus Climax Springs. A donation of \$270.00 provides Buddy Packs for one student for the school year. If you choose to donate to this program, please make your check out to Community Christian Church and write Buddy Packs on the memo line or you may purchase any of the foods on the following list and place them in the grocery cart labeled Buddy Packs found in either the Narthex or the Mission Room. These will be used to supplement each weekend Buddy Pack and also supply extra food for the several four day weekends throughout the year. The Food Bank is not supplying as much this year, so our program needs more help. Let's fill the cart to overflowing. The food list includes: Peanut butter crackers, Pop-top canned fruits, Pop-top canned soup, Pop-top canned meats, Pop-top canned vegetables, Peanut Butter (12oz. plastic jar) supplied once a month, Granola Bars, 100% Fruit Juice.
