The walk serves to raise money to fight hunger -- 75% of the funds raised will be distributed worldwide through Church World Service; 25% remains in the Lake of the Ozarks area and will be given to Share the Harvest. Habitat offers a hand up, not a hand out as they partner with selected families who combine sweat equity along with a small down payment and then in return buy the home utilizing an interest free mortgage.

Since building its first home in 1999, Lake of the Ozarks Habitat for Humanity has completed 23 homes helping 94 residents of Camden County (33 adults and 62 children) get out of inadequate housing situations and into affordable housing.


