

Buddy Packs 2024

The Buddy Pack program in our schools is changing due to the reduced contributions from the Central Mo. Food Bank. As a result, three of the five Elementary schools in the Camdenton R3 District have turned to Community sponsored Food Pantries.

It is estimated that one in six children in Missouri faces hunger on a regular basis. Studies show children who face

food insecurity are more likely to have problems at school and are more likely to suffer from anxiousness and irritability.

Each Friday during the school year, Camdenton schools send home a bag of nutritious food to children who rely on free or reduced-price lunches. The bags include items from the following recommended food donation list:


