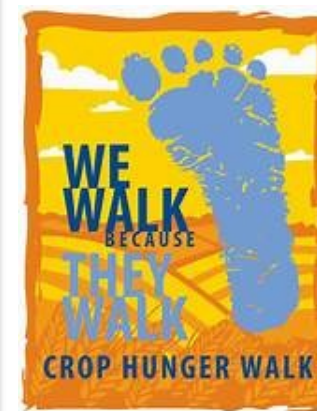

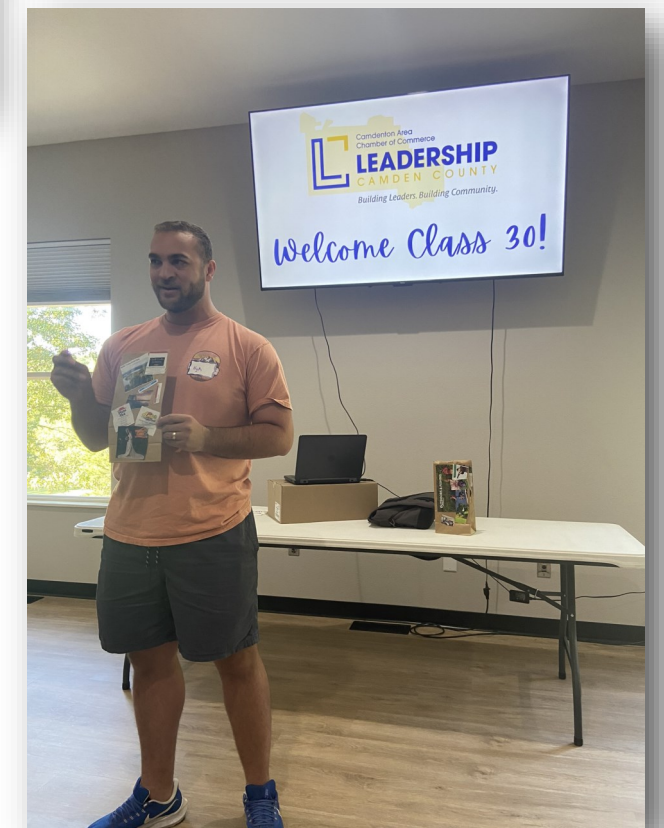

Buddy Packs

2024



The Buddy Pack program in our schools is changing due to the reduced contributions from the Central Mo. Food Bank. As a result, three of the five Elementary schools in the Camdenton R3 District have turned to Community sponsored Food Pantries.

It is estimated that one in six children in Missouri faces hunger on a regular basis. Studies show children who face food insecurity are more likely to have problems at school and are more likely to suffer from anxiety and irritability.

Each Friday during the school year, Camdenton schools send home a bag of nutritious food to children who rely on free or reduced-price lunches. The bags include items from the following recommended food donation list:

- Shelf-stable milk or powdered milk
- Cereal cups/boxes (whole grain)
- SpaghettiOs or ravioli
- Chili/soup/stew in pop-top cans
- Noodles
- Spaghetti sauce
- Macaroni and cheese boxes/cups
- Tuna packets/chicken packets
- Tuna helper kits
- Granola bars

- Fruit grain bars
- Fruit cups
- Apple sauce cups
- Fruit juice
- Canned beans/vegetables/meat (consider pop-tops)
- Cooking oil
- Dried herbs/spices
- Instant mashed potatoes
- Nuts
- Pop-top canned goods

A donation of \$270 provides Buddy Packs to one student for a year.

If you choose to donate to this program, please make your check out to Community Christian Church and write Buddy Packs on the Memo line, or you may purchase any of the foods on the above list and place them in the grocery cart labeled Buddy Packs found in the Fellowship Hall. These will be used to supplement each weekend Buddy Pack and also supply extra food for the several four day weekends throughout the year.

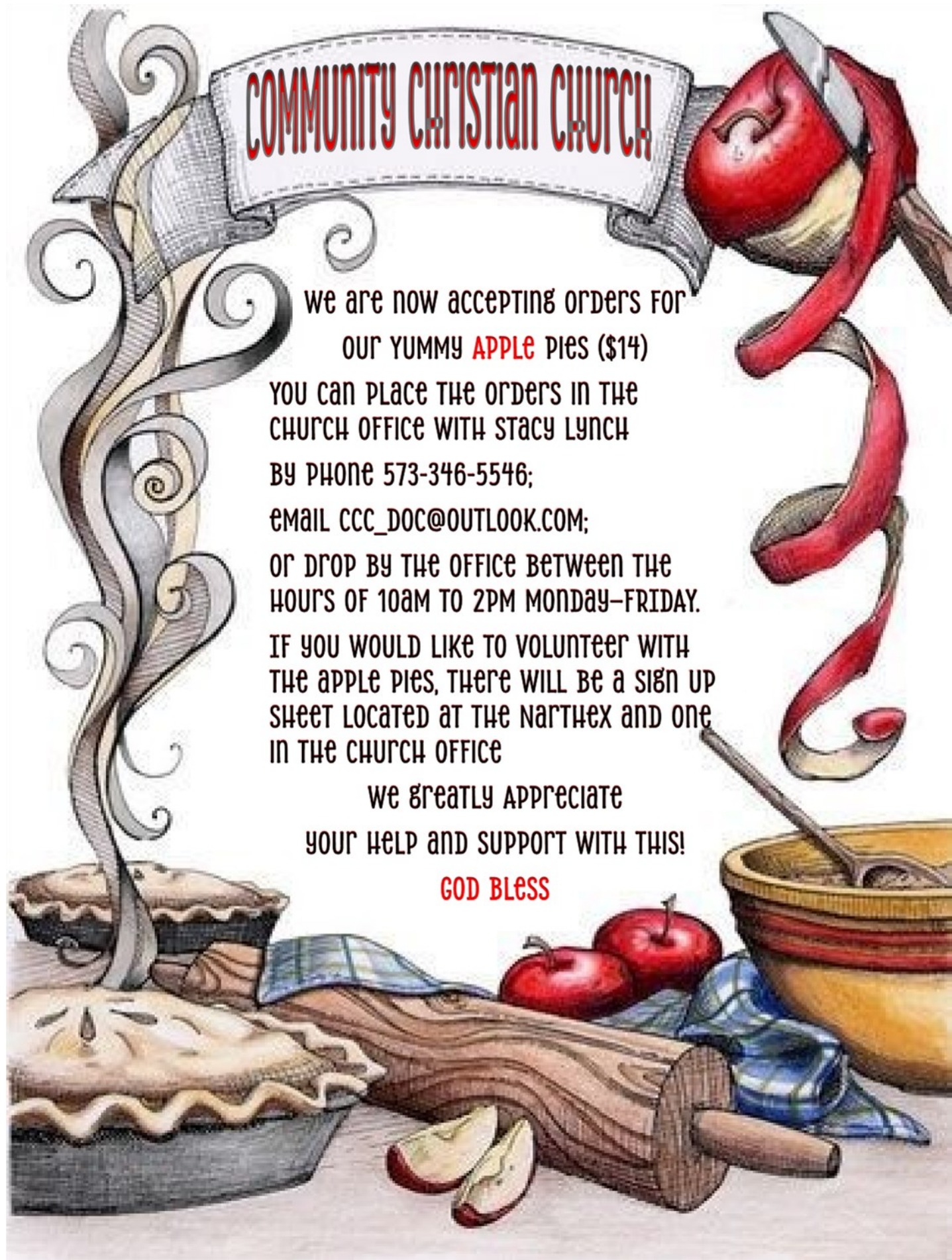
ALUMINUM CANS
