Buddy Packs and How You Can Help

It is time to give thought to children in need in our community. It is estimated that one in six children in Missouri faces hunger on a regular basis. Studies show children who face food insecurity are more likely to have problems at school and are more likely to suffer from anxiety and irritability. Each Friday during the school year, Camdenton schools send home a bag of nutritious food to children who rely on free or reduced-price lunches. The bags include ready to eat entrees, a fruit cup, cereal and a nutritional bar with Peanut Butter once a month. The Camdenton schools are sending home approximately 250 Buddy Packs per week to students in Dogwood, Hawthorn and Oak Ridge Elementary schools plus Climax Springs. A donation of \$270.00 provides Buddy Packs for one student for the school year. If you choose to donate to this program, please make your check out to Community Christian Church and write Buddy Packs on the Memo line or you may purchase any of the foods on the following list and place them in the grocery cart labeled Buddy Packs found in either the Narthex or the Mission Room. These will be used to supplement each weekend Buddy Pack and also supply extra food for the several four-day weekends throughout the year. The Food Bank is not supplying as much this year so our program needs more help. Let’s fill the cart to overflowing. The food list includes: Peanut butter crackers, Pop-top canned fruits, Pop-top canned soup, Pop-top canned meats, Pop-top canned vegetables, Peanut Butter (12oz. plastic jar) supplied once a month, Granola Bars, 100% Fruit Juice. Featured Artist Bill Wood

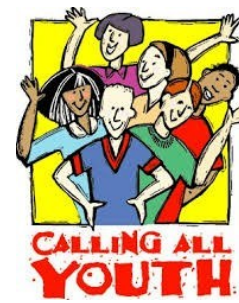


Artwork by Bill Wood is featured in the narthex.

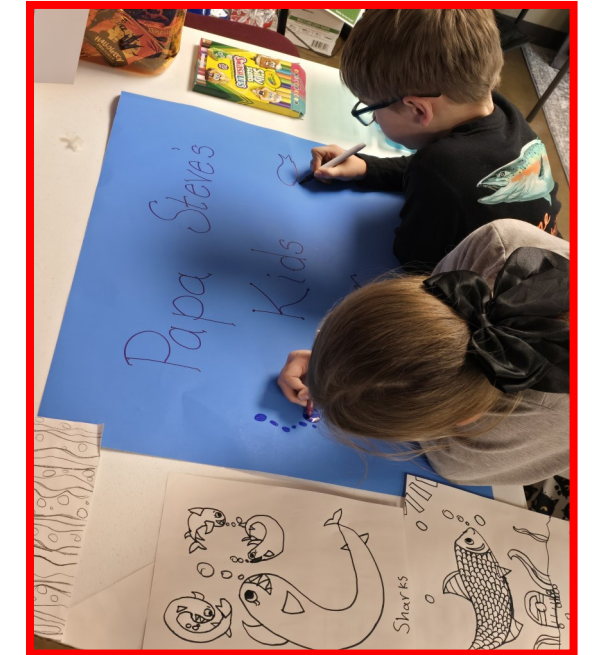

Cottage Cheese & Spinach Crustless Quiche



Ingredients (serves 4-6)

- 1 cup cottage cheese
- 4 large eggs
- 1 cup fresh spinach, chopped (or 1/2 cup thawed frozen, squeezed dry)
- 1/2 cup shredded cheddar or Swiss cheese
- 1/4 cup milk or cream (optional for extra fluff)
- 1/4 tsp garlic powder
- Salt & pepper to taste
- Optional: diced onion or herbs

Step 1: Preheat oven to 375 F. Lightly grease a pie dish or 8X8 baking dish.

Step 2: Mix the filling in a bowl, whisk eggs, cottage cheese, milk, garlic powder, salt and pepper. Stir in Spinach and shredded cheese.

Pour into prepared pan.

Step 3: Bake for 30-35 minutes, or until center is set and is lightly golden.

Let Cool 5-10 minutes before slicing.

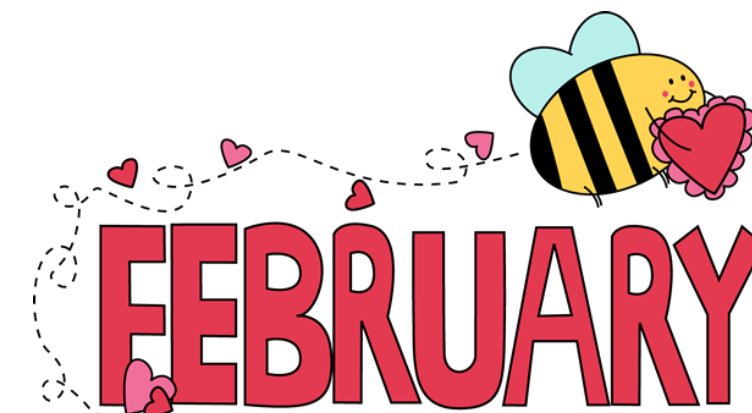

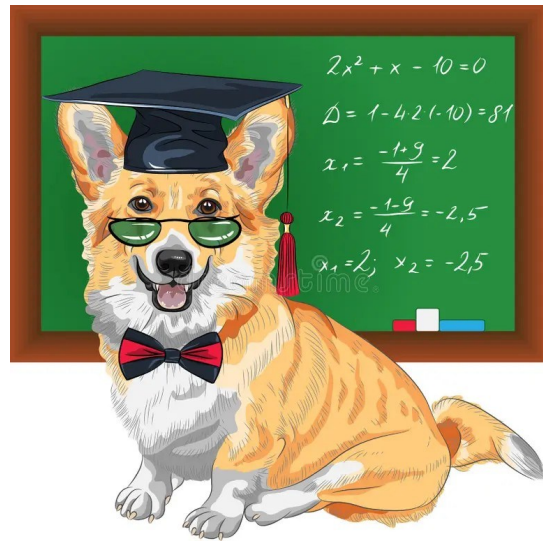

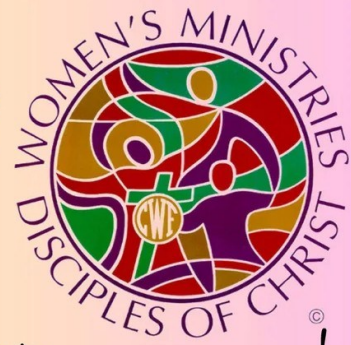
